Duties for both	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Collection of field data from sample farmers throughout the year/ project period by visiting them multiple times. 2. Conduct crop cutting experiment (CCEs) during Kharif and Rabi seasons. [Each selected candidate will be trained thoroughly in CCEs processes]. 3. Enter the data in the specially designed App through Tabs or Smart phones. 4. Check thoroughly the collected and entered data of self and other team members. 5. Provide the daily progress report to the head office 6. Facilitate and support the senior faculty visits from the head office to the field villages and sample farmers and fields. 7. Attend all other tasks assigned by Project Director from time to time 8. In addition, the Supervisor should coordinate and supervise the work of field investigators in the district/ team, and interact with head office and other stakeholders. 9. Investigators should support Supervisor and follow her/ his instructions
